Why VOTE NO on Florida Constitutional Amendment #2

BALLOT LANGUAGE: "RIGHT TO FISH AND HUNT. – Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to preserve forever fishing and hunting, including by the use of <u>traditional methods</u>, as a public right and <u>preferred means</u> of responsibly managing and controlling fish and wildlife. Specifies that the amendment does not limit the authority granted to the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission under Section 9 of Article IV of the State Constitution."

Why Voting "NO" on Amendment 2 Protects Florida

1) "Traditional Methods" = Cruelty to Animals

→ The term "<u>traditional methods</u>" is intentionally vague and will enshrine in our constitution barbaric practices like steel-jaw traps, snares, clubbing, bear hunting with hounds, and gill nets - methods widely outlawed for their cruelty.

2) Undermines Non-Lethal Wildlife Management

→ By making hunting and trapping the "preferred means" of wildlife management, Amendment 2 <u>shifts the focus</u> from humane, science-based methods to lethal methods.

3) No Threat to Hunting & Fishing Rights

→ Amendment 2 proponents <u>falsely claim</u> that these rights are under threat. Florida state law already guarantees the right of every Florida citizen to hunt and fish (Fla. Statute §379.104).

4) Legislators Removed Private Property Protections

→ Amendment 2 implies that an individual's right to hunt, fish and trap <u>supersedes private property rights</u> - enabling hunters and hunting dogs to trespass on private property and discharge firearms in pursuit of wildlife.

5) Special Interest Power Grab

- → Amendment 2 will be used to <u>override Florida's 30-year ban on gill nets</u> that decimate fish populations and kill whales, dolphins, sea turtles, and seabirds.
- \rightarrow It will be used to expand hunting into state parks and wildlife preserves.
- \rightarrow It will also open the door for trophy hunting of Florida Black Bears.

VOTE "NO" on Amendment 2 to protect Florida's wildlife, proven conservation practices, and property rights.
